Visual system for slide demonstration. TFT monitors in front of every second passenger window. Visual scenes are animated (e.g. water, fire, obstacle, all flight
sequences) and static (e.g. gate position, stairs) Visual scenes selectable in day, dusk, night.
Stereo pa amplifier make a very realistic simulation possible (e.g engine start & idle, take-off, climb, cruise, descent, landing, flap movement, crashing, ditching, nose gear collapse, body gear collapse, compressor stall, rejected take-off)
