

INFORMATION ON SAFETY MEASURES AT LAT FACILITIES – TRAINING CENTERS IN GERMANY

Dear Sir or Madam,

Since 1st of October 2022 the following COVID-19 hygiene rules have applied at our training centers in Germany - based on the recommendation issued by the German Federal Government:

- Within the LAT training centers in Germany, a minimum distance of 1.5 meters (6 feet) to other persons must be maintained. If this distance cannot be maintained, mouth-nose protection must be worn as part of the protective measures (Medical or FFP2/KN95 mask)
- Inside our classrooms we ask you to wear a mouth-nose protection (Medical or FFP2/KN95 mask) also when seated if a minimum distance of 1.5 meters (6 feet) from other persons cannot be maintained.

Please note that persons with acute Covid 19 infection (positive test result) are not allowed to enter the LAT training centers until a negative test result is available. This applies to all LAT training locations in Germany, Austria and Switzerland.
